"Prepare the way of the Lord" is the cry of John the Baptist as we prepare for the feast of Christmas and await the second coming of Christ in glory. During the Advent Season, preparation for us might mean the receiving of the Sacrament of Penance, the Rite of Reconciliation. The Second grade students at St. Thomas Catholic School and in our Parish School of Religion received the merciful love of God given in this Sacrament this past week. There are two more opportunities in our parishes this week to participate in this Sacrament of God's Love. This Thursday afternoon at 1:45 pm there will be a Penance Service for St. Thomas

School students and anyone else who wishes to attend. Thursday evening at 6:30 pm a Penance Service will be held for both parishes at St. Mary of the Assumption Church, Ste. Marie. Everyone is welcome to come and be reconciled with God and the Church.

The feast of the Immaculate Conception reminds us that Mary was "Full of Grace" from the moment of her conception. St. Paul tells us to "be holy and blameless in God's sight". May we be made "full of grace" by receiving the merciful love of God in the forgiven of our sins. I recall a second grade student who received the Sacrament for the first time telling her parents to receive it, "Don't you want a clean heart for Jesus at Christmas?"

THIS WEEK I will be in Springfield Tuesday for our monthly Diocesan Tribunal Court. That night there is a meeting regarding the implementation of the recent Diocesan Synodal declarations. Wednesday all of the priests of Diocese are expected to attend a day-long meeting regarding the same. Please notify me 217-494-6326 if any family member is in one of the hospitals in Springfield so that I may visit them.

Since there will be NO Mass Wednesday morning, Deacon Larry Miller will provide a Liturgy of the Word Service with Communion for the 3rd, 4th and 5th grade students and anyone who wishes to attend. Holy Communion will be consecrated at the Mass on Sunday to provide for the Wednesday service.

The recent joint Pastoral Council meeting has recommended that we begin the process of moving to the restoration of the Order of Initiation for everyone. The future for our Diocese will have Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Communion as the order for the reception of the Sacraments as is done in the RCIA for Adults and Children of 7 years of age. Thus our 8th graders this year will be prepared also to receive Confirmation next May 2, 2018. The following year we will have 6-8 graders and then 4-6 grader as we seek to implement the change over the next several years. More on this next week.

The Christmas schedule is: 4 pm Christmas Eve and 9 am Christmas Day at both our parishes. There will be an 11:00 pm Late night Christmas Eve Mass at St. Thomas Church, Newton. NOTE: The 4th Sunday of Advent, December 23/24 Mass schedule is the same as other Sundays.
